Each program was sold out. In all, 750 allied health professionals attended our one-day courses ... at the North Shore, Brigham, Newton-Wellesley, and Mass General Hospitals. And judging by their feedback, most of the participants loved the programs.





We plan to build on this success with four new programs for the Spring of 2004. Two will repeat the introductory program, *Becoming an Asthma Educator*, which is particularly well suited for those preparing to take the exam offered by the National Asthma Educators Certification Board. Two will be "advanced" courses, tentatively entitled *Understanding Allergy* and *Difficult-to-Control Asthma*.

Publication from Partners Asthma Center


A Popular Book About Asthma From Partners Asthma Center
