# Partners Asthma Center's Asthma Educators' Institute Turns 5

In 2003 Partners Asthma Center created its Asthma Educators' Institute and launched a series of one-day seminars (*Becoming an Asthma Educator: Learn to Teach Patients and Families about Asthma*) for nurses, respiratory therapists, pharmacists, and other healthcare professionals. We offered this program at multiple sites (Boston, Newton, and Salem), reflecting our broad collaboration across the Partners network..



We have continued to present four seminars each year, introducing a variety of other, related topics in our "Advanced" programs, including a popular seminar called *Understanding* 

Asthma Educators' Institute *Allergies*. We have had approximately 2000 registrants over the course of the last 4 years! This year's schedule of "Introductory" and "Advanced" courses follows:

May 5: Becoming an Asthma Educator, Pittsfield, MA (in collaboration with Berkshire Area Health Education Center)

Sep. 29: Becoming an Asthma Educator, NWH Oct. 20: Food Allergies and Anaphylaxis, MGH Nov. 17: Asthma Best Practices Summit, BWH

Other projects are on the drawing board: *The Asthma Educators' Handbook* (McGraw-Hill) and an on-line *Becoming an Asthma Educator* course for distance learning.
