## Partners Asthma Center Jeffrey M. Drazen, M.D. Visiting Professorship: Dr. Leonardo Fabbri

Dr. Leonardo M. Fabbri's visit to Partners Asthma Center this fall is taking shape. Here is some biographical information about Dr. Fabbri, followed by the tentative schedule for his visit.

#### Biosketch

Dr. Fabbri received his Degree in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Padua in 1972. He trained in Occupational Medicine at the University of Padua and Respiratory Medicine at the University of Bologna, and spent three years in the U.S. as a Visiting Scientist, first in the Department of Pulmonary Diseases at Tulane University School of Medicine and then at the Cardiovascular Research Institute at the University of California at San Francisco.

He is currently Professor of Respiratory Medicine at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia and Director of the Research Center on Asthma and COPD at the University of Ferrara.

He is a leading figure in the international respiratory community. He has served as a member of the International Committees for the "Global Strategy on Asthma" and the "Global Initiative on Obstructive Lung Disease," sponsored by the WHO and NHLBI. More recently, he has chaired the International Scientific Committee for the "Global Strategy on COPD." He has published widely on occupational asthma and on the molecular biology of asthma and COPD. He served as Editor of the *European Respiratory Review* for several years, and is currently an Associate Editor of the *American Journal of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine*.
